Titel: On the effectiveness of modeling in software development

Abstract:

Modeling is a common part of modern day software engineering practice. Little evidence exists about how models are made and how they help in producing better software. In this talk I will present highlights from my last decade of research in the area of software modeling using UML. Topics that will be addressed: - What is the state of UML modeling in practice and in open source projects? - How can we assess the quality of UML models? - Do UML models actually help in creating better software? Also, I will overview some of the ongoing projects that aim to enhance the effectiveness of modeling.
